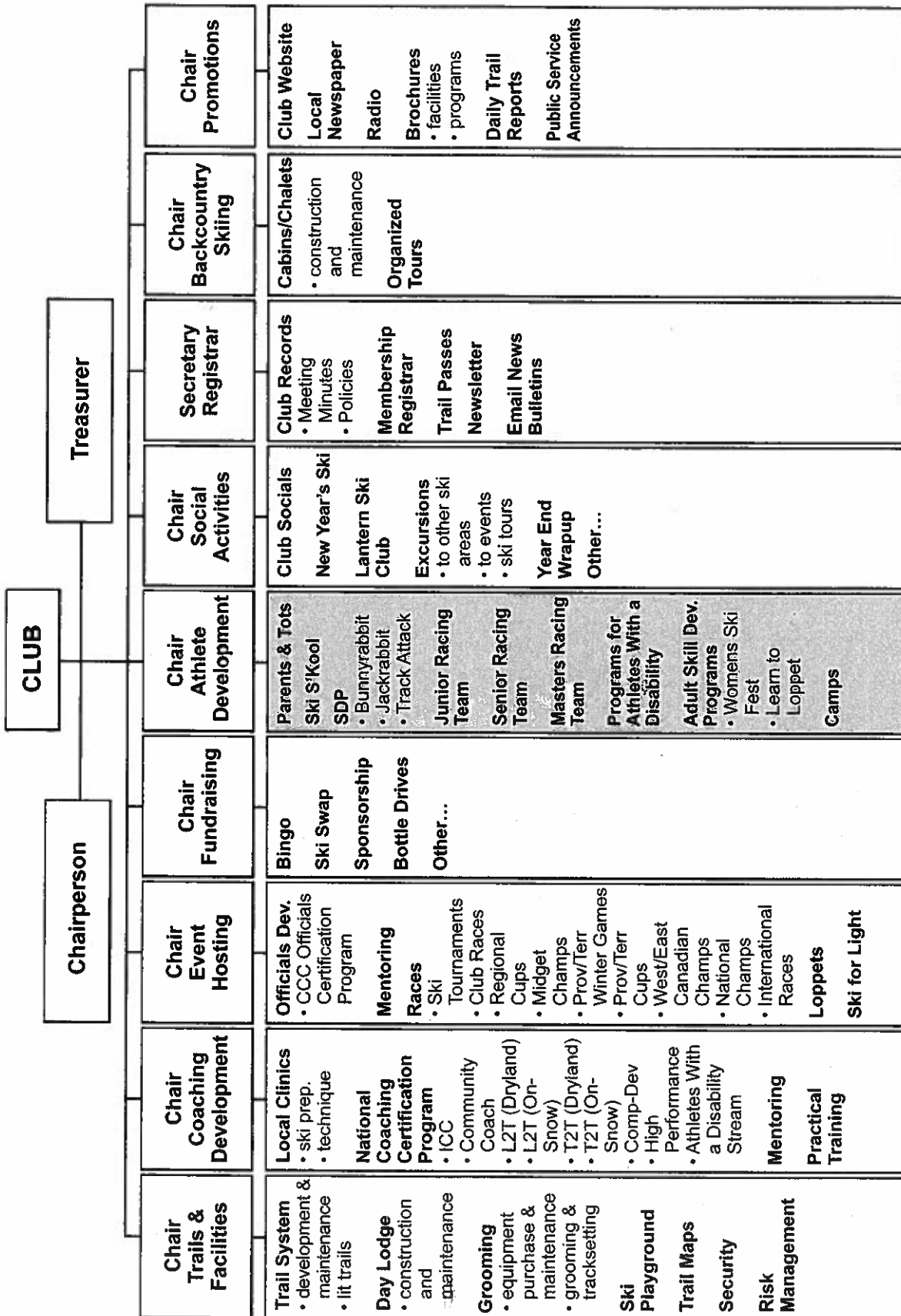

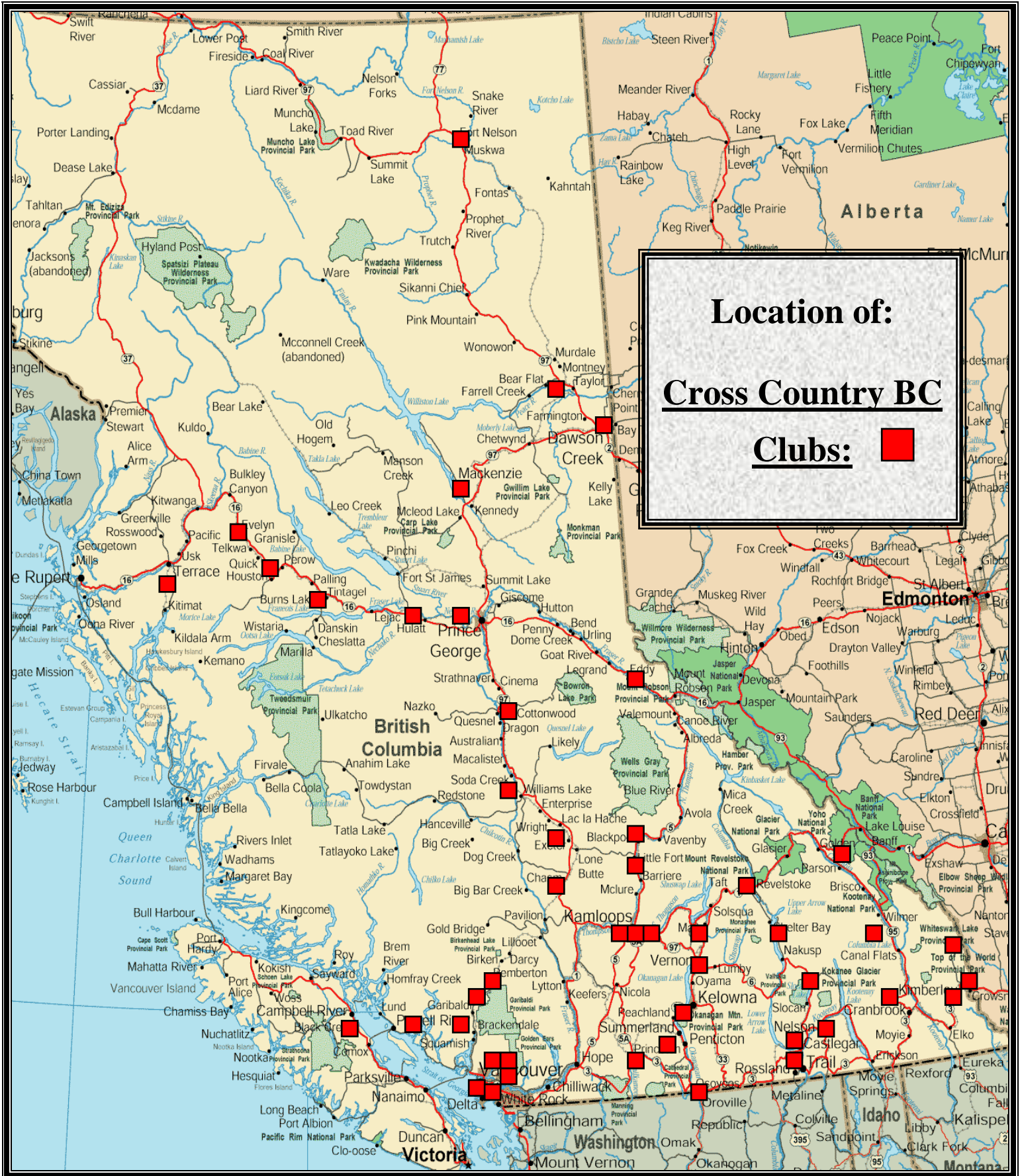

History of Spud Valley Nordics

Started in 1981. When I was teaching at the Coast Mountain Outdoor School (School District 48) we had cross country skiing as part of the curriculum for grade 10 and grade 7 students, and there was a lot of equipment sitting idle on the weekends. As a result I started a ski program for elementary aged children on Saturdays from 10:00 to 1:00. To take part the only children needed to get to the school, which was a 350 acre property 30 km from Pemberton, BC, and pay the registration fee required by CCBC. I was the only coach but we had the parents of the children helping as well as learning to ski themselves - as they also had access to the school equipment too.

During the second season we had a contest among the children to come up with a name for the group and Spud Valley Jackrabbits was born. The program consisted of instruction for the first hour, snack, then relays (the same as the ones we used for the grade 7 & 10 school program – Le Mans, Biathlon, etc), lunch and an long tour around the property before leaving.

The first Spud Valley Loppet was also born out of the Outdoor School program. On the last day of the grade 10 outdoor program all the students had to ski the 11 km distance from the outdoor school property to the residence where all students stayed during their outdoor program. We, a couple of the teaching staff, decided to advertise this route as a race for the local families as well as people in the other communities in SD 48 (Whistler and Squamish). The first was a great success so it just continued on and this year we held the 23 rd Annual Loppet. Over the years a few had to be cancelled because of lack of snow. Here is a quote from the 1991 loppet poster – “The Loppet trail is mostly flat with machine set tracks wherever possible along the route.”

Both the Jackrabbit program and the Loppet continued as described until 1993 when the outdoor school closed and I went to teach in the classroom. There was 1 or 2 years (I'm not sure) when there was no Jackrabbit program or Loppet while I adjusted to the new situation.

In 1995 we started up again this time out of the local elementary school as I had arranged for all the appropriately sized ski equipment to be brought to the elementary school. I used the equipment for my class, a lunch hour program for all students grade 3 – 7, and a jackrabbit program after school on Mondays. By this time there were a few more coaches and many more children because it was now very accessible. We had permission to use the local golf course for our sessions and we had been given a old track setter that could be pulled behind a snowmobile. Since the club had no snowmobile we had parents with snowmobiles volunteer whenever they were available to track set.

Needless to say, there were many problems with the above system – too many kids, not enough coaches, tracks set only some times, and people skiing where they shouldn't be on the golf course.

The next year the Jackrabbit program was open only to children with their own ski equipment. We used farmer's fields for the program which still ran after school. The location of each week's session changed depending where there was enough but not too much snow, as we rarely had any tracks set.

At this time we also started a Junior race team. This was made up of 5 children who had made a trip to 100 Mile House the winter before to participate in a BC Championships race. Both the kids and the parents really enjoyed the experience and the results and wanted to continue to be involved in the 'race scene'. Our 'Spud Valley racers' were very noticeable at that race with their 3 pin bindings, long loose pants, heavy

winter jackets and bulky mittens; but their results were also something to take note of – all finished in the top half of their category.

From then on the Junior Race team skied in the farmers fields as a part of the Jackrabbit program on Mondays and then again on Whistler's Lost Lake trails every Wednesday evening. Once again this little team stood out as they were usually the only children using the trails and the only ones (other than the first-time tourist from Florida) classic skiing. Being the only kids' race team in the area we had three kids from Squamish and two from Whistler join our Spud Valley Junior Racers. *(One of these Squamish kids went to the BC Winter games in Quesnel along with a couple of skiers from Pemberton.)*

After attending one of the club workshops at 100 Mile House, where I learned about the advantages of being a non-profit society, our club became the Spud Valley Nordic Society and have never looked back.. With the gaming grants that we have been receiving our club now owns a Ginsu Groomer , a snowmobile, club skate skis, club waxable classic skis, a wide variety of 'Ski Playground' equipment, as well as pays to train and certify coaches, pays kids race fees and subsidizes travel costs to attend races. Our club, for the past six years has an agreement with BC Parks to use Nairn Falls Campground from November to April each year as our ski facility where we have 3 km of groom trails for both skate and classic.

Over the years skiers from the Spud Valley Nordics have been on the BC Development Team, the BC team, various university teams and have skied and competed in various parts of the world, including places like Yellowknife, Quebec and Norway. Our club athletes have won medals at the BC Winter Games (3), and competed nationally many times. Some of our skiers have continued to be involved in skiing as coaches and instructors as far away as Prince George and Ottawa as well as being volunteers at the 2010 Winter Games.

And can you imagine – all that without ever having a day lodge, and for most of our history – no groomed trails.

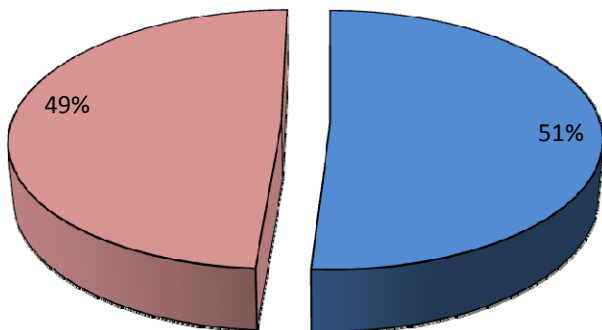

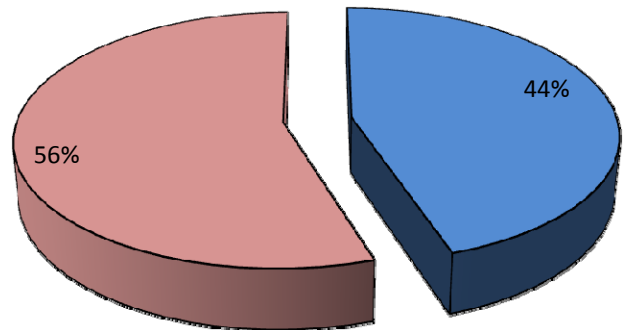
Male/Female Coach ratio who took part in "Coaching Development Opportunities" during the 2010-2011 Season

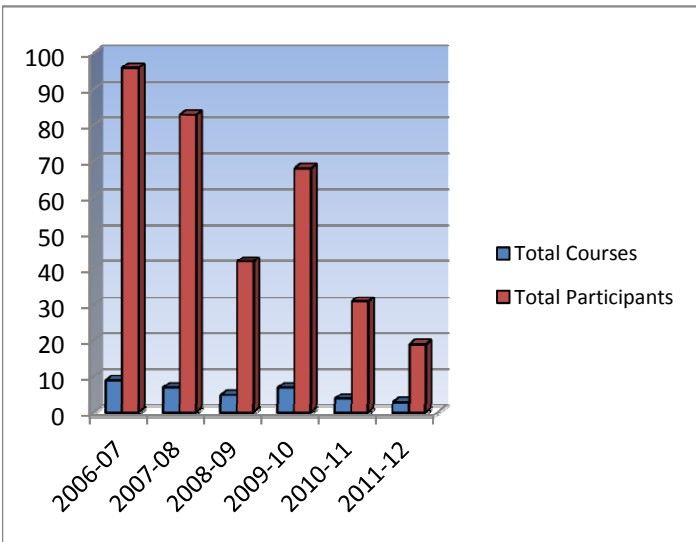

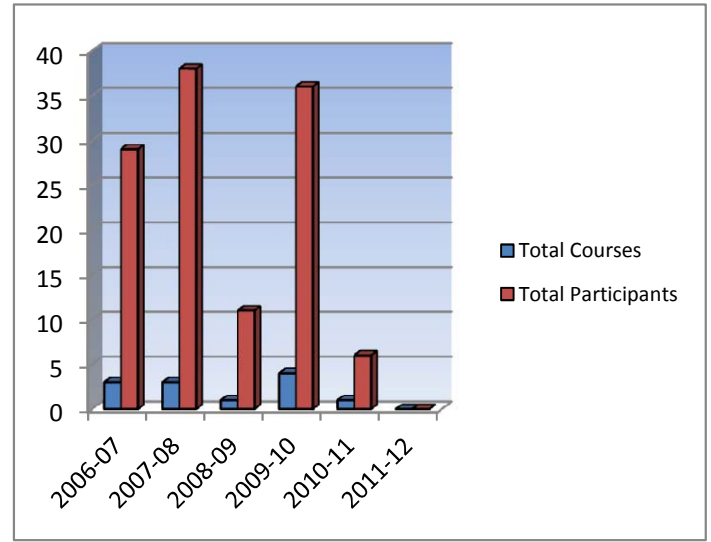

CCC OFFICIALS CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

This program consists of five steps from entry level to international level. It includes course conductor training, technical delegate training and event management as well as technical training.

Level 1

This is a 10 hour course that provides an overview of what a cross-country ski competition is all about. The focus is on the duties of minor officials for both Olympic Style ((individual start, mass start, pursuit start, relay start and sprints) and Loppet Style (mass participation) competitions. Course fee: \$60.00

Level 2

This is a 16 hour course that prepares officials for a leadership role on a competition committee for club, provincial and national competitions including the BC Cup Series, BC Winter Games and loppets. The course covers all official race formats, rules and regulations, rule interpretation, electronic timing, all aspects of the results system, and volunteer management. Course fee: \$75.00

Level 3

This is a 3.5 day course. It is designed to prepare an official to: (1) effectively structure, staff and manage a Competition Committee at Provincial through National level competitions, (2) perform any major official role at the National Championship level, (3) perform the role of a provincial Technical Delegate, and (4) have a good understanding of CCC/FIS rules.

Please note the requirements for participation in Officials Certification Courses - levels 1 & 2. Course pre-requisites will be strictly enforced. For more information about course pre-requisites visit the CCBC website at:

ZONE4 CLINICS

ZONE4 is Cross Country BC's official race management software. All nationally and provincially sanctioned competitions held in BC - BC Cup Series, BC Sprint Championships, Nor Ams / Continental Cups and National Championships - produce standardized results through the use of this program.

ZONE4 Clinic - Introduction:

This clinic provides a general overview of Zone4 and prepare participants to use it for running club races, regional cup races and similar types of events. Topics will include the tasks of the competition secretary and timekeeping departments as they relate to ZONE4, online registration, posting results, etc.

ZONE4 Clinic - Advanced:

Preparing a start list for the different race formats (interval, individual sprint, team sprint, traditional relay, pursuit and mass start); doing a draw; producing results and interfacing the software program with CCBC electronic timing equipment (Chronomix – Compusport 737) will all be covered during this clinic.
